III. The Pantomime

Repeat first section for 30 seconds

- Soprano can repeat each box as many times as they wish, with or without gaps between boxes and after the first circular iteration, they can be presented in any order in any order. Across the 30 seconds the agitation and intensity should increase until absurdity is reached. Boxes without dynamics should have their dynamics varied each time but generally in keeping with the growing intensity.

- Cello can repeat boxes as many time as they wish, with or without gaps between the boxes and in any order from the first iteration. Across the 30 seconds the intensity should increase in line with the soprano part, reaching a level of absurdity.
